

# **INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME**

As part of **tralac**'s capacity building initiatives we offer an Internship Programme.

## 1. Objectives of the Internship Programme

The objective of the **tralac** internship programme is to offer to young African graduates with a background in trade related disciplines an opportunity, to gain a better understanding of international trade matters, and to provide them with an opportunity to contribute to the interdisciplinary (trade law and economics) analysis of trade and regional integration matters, specifically as they pertain to African countries.

The programme in turn provides **tralac** with the assistance of outstanding recent graduates specialising in trade law, economics, international relations or another trade-related discipline.

## 2. Eligibility

- Applicants should be recent graduates with at least a Masters degree in a trade-related discipline
- Applicants should be nationals of African countries.

## 3. Conditions of the Internship

- For the duration of the internship at **tralac**, Interns are **not** considered as employees of **tralac**.
- This is a full-time programme. Interns spend 5 days a week (7 hours a day, including a one-hour lunch break) from 09:00 to 16:00 at **tralac**, working on a programme or assignment under the supervision of a **tralac** staff member.
- At the end of the Internship, an Intern is required to submit a written report to the Executive Director of **tralac** on his or her activities during the internship period. This report has to be submitted before the end of an internship with **tralac**.

## 4. Application Procedure
