


## Intra-Africa trade and tariff profile 2018

Senegal is a member of both the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) and the Community of Sahel-Saharan States (CEN-SAD)

ECOWAS currently has 15 member states. All 15 are part of the ECOWAS Free Trade Area and all, but Cape Verde, are in the process of implementing the ECOWAS Common External Tariff (CET).

CEN-SAD has 24 member states. In 2013 a revised CEN-SAD Treaty was approved but is not yet in force. Accordingly, there is currently no free trade agreement in place.


Intra-Africa exports: 43% of world exports


Intra-Africa imports: 16% of world imports

Intra-Africa export products



Main export products




# Intra-Africa tariffs

Senegal subscribes to the ECOWAS ETLs enabling all qualifying goods sourced from approved producers in the other ECOWAS member states to be imported into Senegal duty-free. The highest average ad valorem applied tariff is 35% and there are no specific import duties. Most of the goods imported into Senegal from African countries other than ECOWAS member states entered with 5% and 10% MFN applied duties



African imports from outside ECOWAS are levied MFN applied duties (ECOWAS CET)

Of the top 20 import products only three products are imported duty-free – medicaments, liquefied butanes and urea. 5% duties are levied on imports of coal, unassembled diesel goods vehicles, certain medium oils and preparations, hot-rolled bars and rods of iron or steel, fertilisers and unassembled diesel passenger vehicles. 35% duties are applicable to imports of soaps and palm oil.

-  Palm oil (35%)
-  Potatoes and onions (35%)
-  Apples and pears (20%)
-  Food preparations (syrups) (20%)
-  Assembled and used diesel passenger vehicles (20%)
-  Soya bean oil (20%)
-  Paper and plastic sacks and bags (20%)
-  Beer (20%)
-  Assembled and used diesel goods vehicles (10%)
