

With exception of Asia and Oceania, South Africa had a trade surplus with other regions


In 2021 ASIA was the largest trading partner with total trade at ZAR 1.3 trillion, followed by Europe, Africa and America (total trade = exports + imports) **D ZAR 3.2 trn** Global trade

Key Preferential Trade Agreements Update (2021)



Southern Africa Customs Union (SACU) - Customs Union with Common External Tariff (CET). Members include Botswana, Eswatini, Lesotho & Namibia



Southern Africa Development Community Free Trade Agreement (SADC FTA) - 16 member states. 13 members are part of the SADC FTA. Angola has made a tariff offer to accede, while several countries including Malawi & Zimbabwe have not fully implemented their phasedowns subject to derogations



African Continental Free Trade Agreement (AfCFTA) - 54 African Countries committed to duty free quota free access to each other's markets. Also committed to liberalise trade in services, Investment as well as promote infrastructure development





European Union - SADC Economic Partnership Agreement (EU-SADC EPA) -FTA comprising Botswana, Lesotho, Mozambique, Namibia, South Africa and Eswatini. Angola has applied to accede and will do so after acceding to the SADC FTA **SACU - European Free Trade Association (EFTA) -** FTA between SACU member states and EFTA members consisting of four European states: Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland.




UK - SACUM EPA - Economic partnership between the UK, SACU member states and Mozambique. Since BREXIT, the UK-SACUM EPA aims to ensure preferences under the EU-SADC EPA are not eroded







- Imports from countries outside SACU and SADC face MFN applied duties (SACU CET).
- The African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) will see commercially meaningful trade on at least 90% products that will
 have duty free quota free access to member states markets once tariff concessions have been agreed upon and verified by the
 AfCFTA Secretariat








BRICS growth (total trade) (2020-2021)

ago.

South Africa's Trade with Brazil

- South Africa is party to the preferential trade agreement between the Southern African Customs Unions (SACU) and the Southern Common Market (Mercosur).
- In 2021 total trade was just of ZAR 26 billion with trade skewed in favour of Brazil.
- Both exports and imports increased by 42% and 10% respectively over the review period - 2020 - 2021.
- Key exports included Iron & Steel, Chemicals and Mineral products. \bullet
- Key imports included Live Animals, Equipment components and Products of Iron & Steel.

South Africa's Trade with Russia


- South Africa's trade with Russia is the lowest amongst the BRIC countries at ZAR 15.2 billion in 2021, although Russia has a trade surplus with South Africa.
- In 2021 total trade grew by a mere 3% from ZAR 14.8 billion in 2020
- Exports to Russia declined by 2%, while imports increased by 7% and over the review period - 2020 - 2021.
- Key exports included Vegetables and mineral products which accounted for 72% of South Africa's total exports to Russia in 2021.
- Key imports included Products of Iron & Steel, Chemicals, Mineral products and Vegetables, which accounted for 81% of total imports.




