

Tanzania is a member of the East African Community (EAC), the Southern Africa Development Community


(SADC) and the Intergovernmental Authority on Development (IGAD) The African Continental Free Trade Agreement (AfCFTA) entered into force on 30 May 2019

Tanzania ratified the AfCFTA, however countries have not started trading under the AfCFTA regime


