BENIN TRADE & TARIFF UPDATE (2021)

Regional Economic Communities • Benin is part of two Regional Economic Communities (RECs) -

- the Community of Sahel-Saharan States (CEN-SAD) and the Economic Community of West Africa (ECOWAS).
- Benin deposited its instrument of ratification and schedule of tariff concessions, along with other ECOWAS member states.


- CEN-SAD currently has 24 member states aspiring to establish an Economic Union for the free movement of goods, services and commodities.
- There is currently **no free trade** agreement in place.


- a customs union with a Common External Tariff (CET).




