
# **SOUTH AFRICA'S ITAC INVESTIGATIONS (2022)**

ITAC INVESTIGATIONS COVER PRIMARILY ORDINARY CUSTOMS DUTIES (APPLICATIONS FOR INCREASING OR REDUCING IMPORT TARIFFS AND REBATES); TRADE REMEDIES; AND IMPORT AND EXPORT CONTROL MEASURES

### SUMMARY

- Tariff investigations remain the main request by companies averaging 15 investigations annually over the review period
- The period 2014/2015 recorded the highest tariff investigations (23 total) and 2019/2020 recording the lowest (10 total).

According to ITAC, 30 reports were completed in 2022, however, in this report, 23 are highlighted mainly because the remaining 7 reports are not original reports which were initiated and reported in the previous year Investigations by type of instrument (2022) Trends in investigations (2014-2022)


