Regional phase

The regional phase of the International Training Programme on Rules of Origin takes place in Cape Town, South Africa, March 22nd until 26th. It is a one-week-follow up seminar organised by the National Board of Trade in cooperation with Trade Law Centre For South Africa (Tralac) and funded by the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida).
