

In consultation with a number of international organizations, the OGP Open Data Working Group has developed a revised International Open Data Charter.

It contains 5 principles:

- ○Open by Default;
- OQuality and Quantity;
- ○Useable by All;
- Engagement and Empowerment of Citizens; and
- oCollaboration for Development and Innovation.

Within each principle, a handful of clauses clarify the obligations for countries and organizations implementing open data in their own jurisdiction.


