# ABIDJAN, gateway to the ECOWAS

The fourth **AFRICA CEO FORUM** will be held on 21 and 22 March 2016 in Abidjan, Côte d'Ivoire. This is the first time the forum will be held on the African continent. Côte d'Ivoire hosts **the headquarters of the African Development Bank** and is one of the driving forces for regional integration within the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS). Together, the 15 member countries of ECOWAS have a population of more than 300 million people and the region has consistently had the highest growth in Africa over the last five years (more than 7% in 2014).
