

WHAT DETERMINES

Supply chain reliability is a key determinant of logistics performance. It is more important than the speed of delivery. Many shippers are willing to pay a premium for a high degree of certainty on when and how deliveries will take place. RELIABILITY MAT Around 1,000 logistics professionals rated **infrastructure** in each region. ICT and airports generally rated high. Rail, warehousing and transloading
