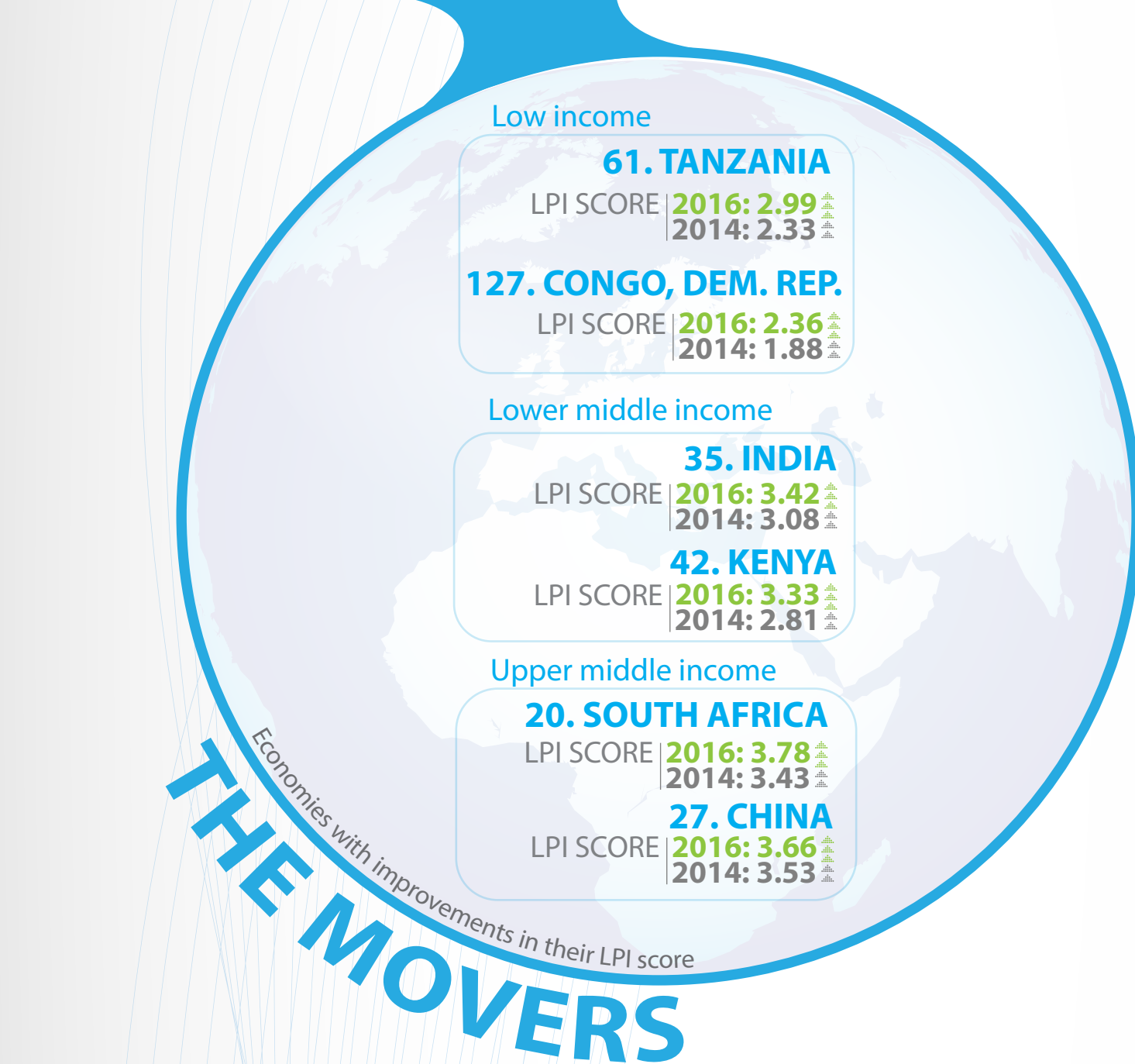
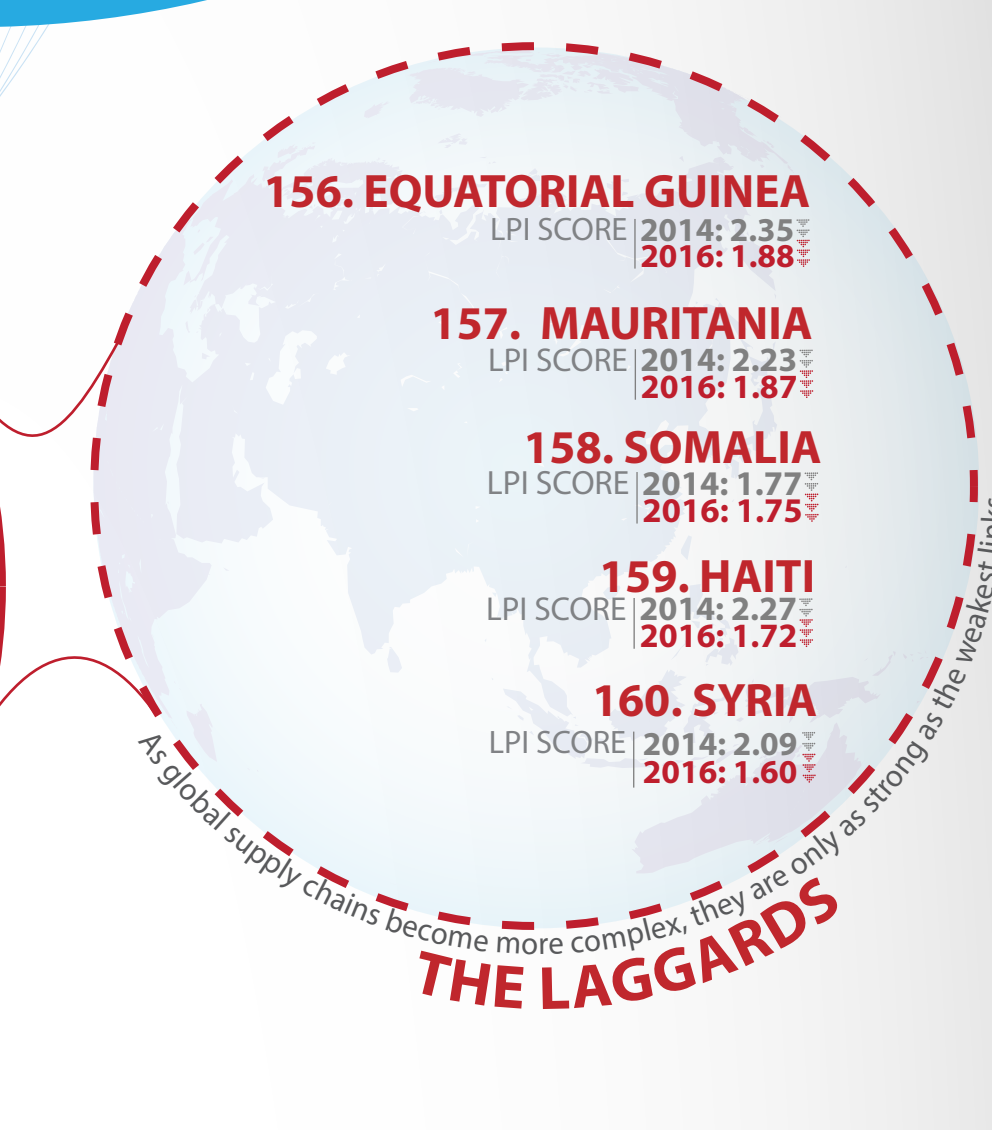
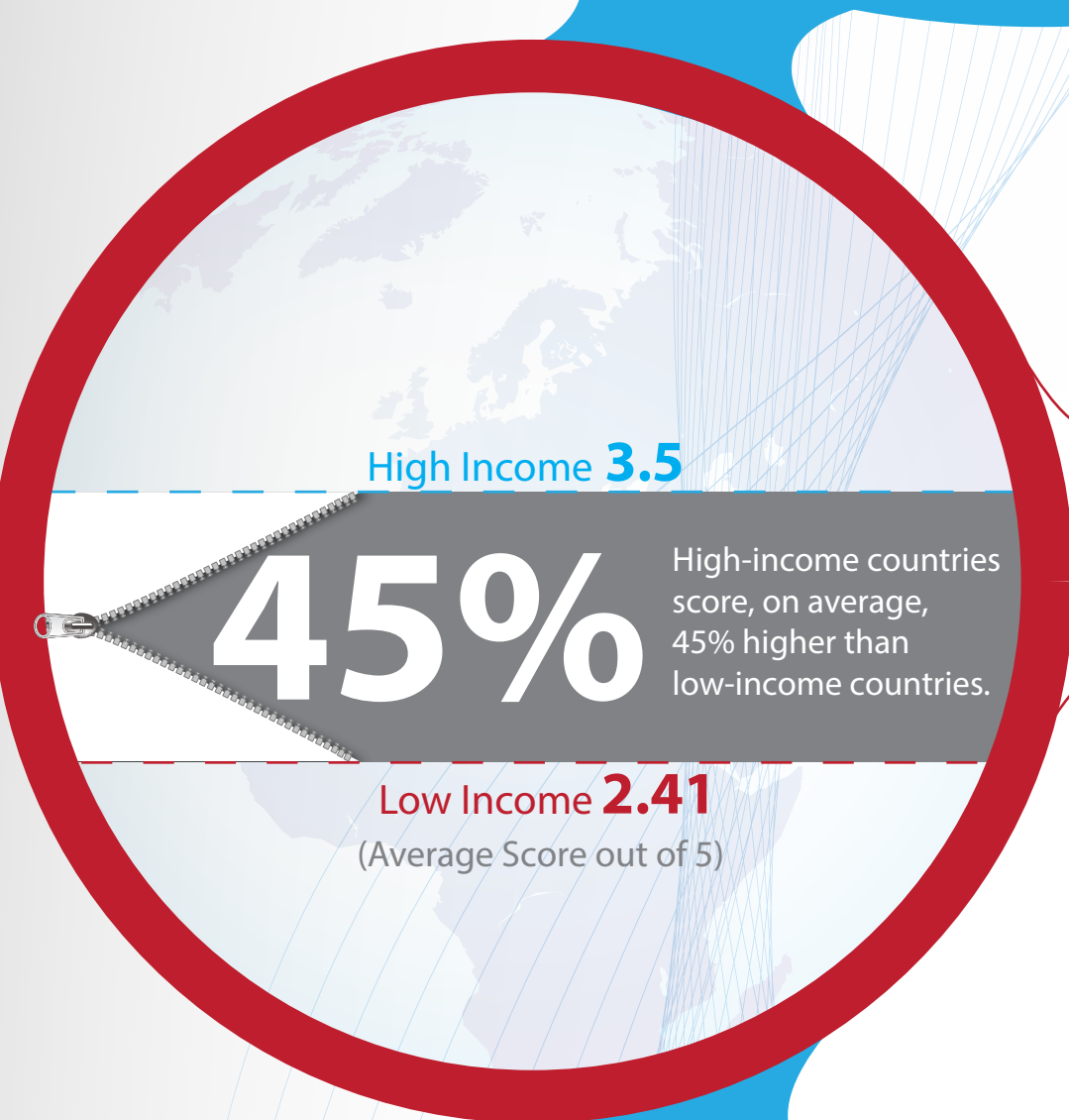


# LOGISTICS: HOW COUNTRIES STACK UP

## WHAT DETERMINES LOGISTICS PERFORMANCE?



Around 1,000 logistics professionals rated **infrastructure** in each region. **ICT** and **airports** generally rated high. **Rail, warehousing** and **transloading** rated low.

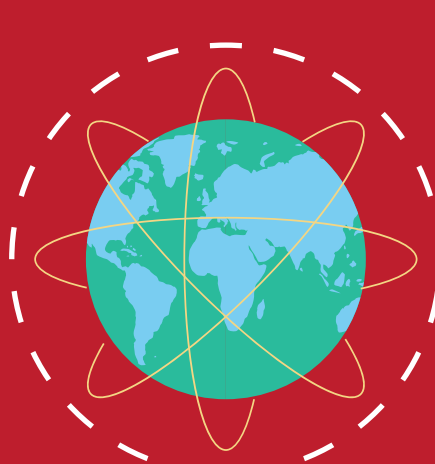
